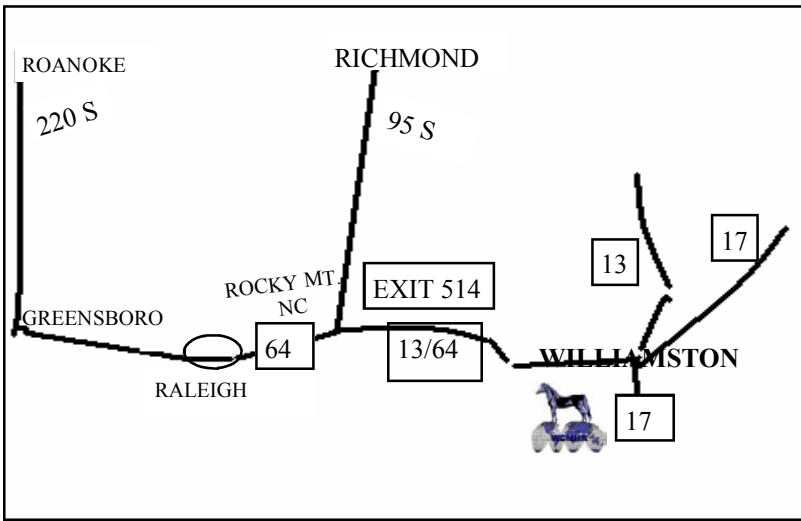

WCMHR 2003 World Championship Miniature Horse Rules and Regulations Show Rules available at wcmhr.com

1. Entry Postmark or credit card by telephone or fax by July 25, 2003. Entries received without payment do not meet the deadline and will be accessed the \$2 per class late fee for all entries after July 25, 2003... **Post Entries** will be received at the show up until one class before the class to be entered at an additional cost of **\$2 per class**.
4. Scratched or Withdrawn Classes will be refunded and **limited** to only Horses with a written veterinary report attesting to injury or illness of **said horse**. Substitutions allowed up to one class before with an additional fee of \$2 per class per horse
5. Entries are limited to Current WCMHR Members and WCMHR Miniature Horses or Show Ponies. Open Registry Period allows Participants to become Members and Register Animals to participate in this Show. Membership: \$32 Youth \$5 Miniature Horse or Show Pony Registration : \$15 per animal.
7. **Classes 1-6 and 13-81 are \$12 per class. Classes 7-12 are \$15 per class, not per horse. Only one horse's name on entry.**
8. All Horses or Show Ponies must be sound, without blindness or dwarfism and have good conformation .
9. Provide a Current Copy of Negative Coggins within the past 12 months for each and every horse or show pony.
10. Copy of WCMHR Certificate of Registration must accompany all entries or provide date submitted if Pending
11. Hampton Inn Official Host Hotel. Make reservations before July 7, 2003 to receive Show Rate of \$69 for double.
12. Veterinary and Farrier Services will be posted at the Show.
13. All Classes will be held according to entries. Management reserves the right to add classes according to entries.
14. **RV Sites** will be available for \$30 per show with water and electricity. There is a dumping station on premises.
15. Stalls will be available at \$30 for the Show. You may arrive on Aug. 8th. and depart morning Aug. 11th. . No Refunds on Stalls.
16. Shavings will be available @ \$6 per bale.
17. Horses may be shown out of Trailers and not Stalled at \$15 per horse for the show.
18. A **"Minis for Sale Class"** has been included to enable miniature horse breeders an owners an opportunity to present animals that they have available for sale. All horses will receive a Participation Ribbon. Owners must provide a script that can contain a pedigree or any other pertinent information to be read by the Announcer for each horse as it enters the ring. All for sale horses in this Class must be currently registered with WCMHR or proof of pending registration. Lead, Ride, or Drive.
19. Any Horse to be registered at the Show will receive a Registration Number. Certificates will be mailed to Owner.
20. **Youths** will show at the age they were on January 1, 2003.. Youths under 12 may not show Stallions over 2 years of age. There will be no penalty for Adults riding with Youth in any Driving Class. Adults may not assist verbally or physically .
21. Classes that are designated as "Adult" are for those that are 18 years of age or older
22. Classes not designated as Youth or Adult are open to any age.
23. **Showmanship Classes** require a hat, boots, and jeans or long pants, and a long-sleeved shirt. Gloves are not required. The Exhibitor is being Judged , not the Horse. However, the Horse should be clean, well groomed, and with good conformation.
24. **Liberty Classes**-Horse is lead into Ring and released to run free and demonstrate a variety of gaits to music selected by the Exhibitor that is set for one and a half minutes. Two people are allowed in the Ring. The Exhibitor who released the Horse must also be the one to catch and re-halter within 2 minutes after the music stops.
25. Dress for all Driving Classes should be appropriate to the turnout. Western attire is always acceptable in any class.
26. **Entry Level Classes** are designated to enable a first-time exhibitor or an exhibitor who has not shown for more than two years (2 show seasons) in a particular class to have an opportunity to compete against others with the same experience. These Participants **are not** limited to only Entry Level Classes. Entry Level Classes qualify for High-Point Entry Level Awards.
27. Physically/Mentally Challenged Classes. Participants qualify for High-Point PM/T awards. Participants **are not** limited to only these classes.
28. **Halter Breed Classes** are Judged on the Horse, not the Exhibitor. Exhibitors walks into with horse in hand, trots, past Judge, and lines up. Judged upon Way of Going, Conformation, and Overall Appearance.
29. **Model Classes** — horses 2 years or older and are judged on conformation and overall appearance. No Trotting Required.
30. **Color Classes are judged 100% on color.** No Trotting Required.
31. **Hunter Classes**-Exhibitor & Horse in hand approach the obstacles to jump at an even pace and maintain style and grace.
32. **Jumping Classes**—Exhibitor enters the Ring with Horse in hand and overtakes a series of jumps. The ability to jump heights is foremost with faults for refusals, etc., from the start to finish. A jump off may take place if there is a tie of two or more for first place. Twenty-Four Inches is the average jump height for Youth and Entry Level. Heights may go up to 36" in open class to determine the Champion in a jump off.
33. **Mini Trail**—overcoming at least 5 obstacles on a course designed with poles to cross or back into, bridges, circles, gates /other objects.
34. **Pleasure Driving Horses** should be shown in a cart at a walk, slow trot, and working or strong trot. Exhibitors line up in center and are asked to reign back. No penalty for adults riding with youths. Headers are required for Youths .
35. **Roadster Driving**— 3 gaits-Jog Trot, Road Gait, and Fully extended Drive-On Trot. Horses do not reign back. Bike Type or Sulky .
36. **Obstacle Driving**—Driving horse through a series of obstacles. Backing up through an obstacle.
37. **Barrel Racing**—Sulkies or carts circle cones twice; each Horse has its own cone to circle. Usually, 2-3 horses race at a time. Horse is disqualified if it breaks the trot more than twice. Horses may be A Div. Or B Div. Show Ponies may compete with 2 or more entries.
38. All entries will be under the direction and control of the Show Management. And Require a signed Waiver of Liability by all participants that is provided on Entry Forms. In the absence of a signed waiver, any arrival upon show grounds will signify an acceptance to all of the terms, rules, and regulations set forth by the entry form and waiver of liability.
39. Proper conduct is required at all times. All Animals must be treated with due care . Any misconduct or mistreatment of animals will be grounds for dismissal from the Show Grounds, Sportsmanship Award for outstand Adult and Youth.
40. Announcements made at show take precedence over any written documents.
